Competition Rules



RCCC Rules will apply and the decision of the Chief Umpire will be final.

For your first game an Original Team Line-Up Form must be completed and submitted to the Umpires and thereafter if there are any team changes or a change in the team rotation a Change of Team Line-Up form must be submitted before the start of the game. All forms are available from the Umpire.

The initial stages will be played in sections. 2 points will be awarded for a win and 1 point for a draw. Ends scored, shots +/- and total shots shall count in the event of a tie and also for ranking.

All games will be 8 ends or the bell (1 hour 50 minutes).

Last stone advantage will be decided using Last Stone Draw (LSD). LSD for game 1 will be played at the conclusion of the team's pre-game practice. Subsequently the LSD (without practice stones) will be played at the end of each game to determine which team will have choice in its next game.

Knockout Stages

- Junior Men
 - The top 2 teams from each section will qualify for the knockout stages (6 Teams)
 - Rank the Teams (points, ends, shots up, total shots)
 - Teams ranked 1 - 2 will qualify straight to the semi-finals
 - Teams ranked 3 - 6 will qualify for the quarter finals
- Junior Women
 - The top 4 teams will qualify for the semi finals
 - 1v4 and 2v3

During the knockout stages if a game is tied after 8 ends, one extra end will be played. If the game still is tied, the team without hammer in extra end is the winner, except from the tournament final where additional extra ends will be used to decide the winner.

The Finals and 3/4 play offs must be contested for a minimum of six ends to be eligible for prizes and Asham Under 21 Slam points.

Asham Under 21 Slam

Separate male and female competitions will be run within each event and points will be awarded to the top eight male teams and top four female teams who have registered for the Under 21 Slam and paid the appropriate fee.

In order to continue accruing points on Under 21 Slam Leaderboard no more than six players may be used by one team in any given season. On use of 7th player in any tournament, points awarded in that event will be listed as a new team on the Under 21 Slam Leaderboard.

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Where 2 or more teams are tied at the end of the season the below rules apply to determine ranking:

- Highest number of tournament wins
- Highest number of finishes in the points
- Highest number of tournaments entered

£1000 will be awarded to the overall top male team and £1000 to the overall top female team. In addition to the overall Slam prizes, there will be prizes at each individual competition.
